The English premiere of Gwenlyn Parry's modern Welsh-language classic, *Saer Doliau* (*'Doll Mender'*) – performed in the original Welsh – opens at the Finborough Theatre for a limited run of nine Sunday and Monday evening and Tuesday matinee performances from Sunday, 3 February 2013 (**Press Night: Monday, 4 February 2013 at 7.30pm**).

Doll mender Ifans is peacefully at work in his wood workshop in rural Wales. Until suddenly his entire life is ripped apart by the unannounced intrusion of two strangers, a Girl and a Lad. As they torment him with their own secret agenda and mind games, Ifans loses his grip on his reality, leaving him adrift in a world which is changed too quickly. As the two strangers play one final deadly game, and he is left deserted by everyone, Ifans is left questioning the purpose of his entire existence...

This Welsh-language classic from 1966 is a fascinating study of our obsession with modernisation, the role of women in society and racial prejudice, while also asking searching questions about our conscience and existence itself.

Saer Doliau will be performed in Welsh with English surtitles.

Playwright **Gwenlyn Parry** (1932-1991) was one of the most prominent figures of twentieth-century Welsh-language literature. He wrote several key Welsh plays including $Y T \hat{w} r$, S = Doliau, $T \hat{y} = a r y T y wod$, P = a nd S = a loss =

Director **Aled Pedrick** received the prestigious Bryn Terfel scholarship and trained as an actor at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama. He has been an acting coach at the Saturday Acting Academy and Belfast's Music Theatre 4 Youth, and has co-directed with Tom Daley and Richard Twyman. He was Assistant Director to Polly Teale on Shared Experience's production of Speechless. His acting experience includes *Teulu* (S4C), *The Pride* (English Theatre Company), *Spring Awakening* (Theatr Genedlaethol Cymru), *The Sanger* (Sherman Cymru), *The Nutcracker* (Theatre Royal Bath), *Attempts On Her Life* (Sherman Cymru), *Doctor Who* (BBC), *Gari Tryfan* (S4C), *Lewis* (ITV) and *Aki Nabalu* (Astro, Malaysia).
